



## CSkills Achieving Behavioural Change



### Course Objectives:

This course is designed to provide delegates with an understanding of how attitude, behaviour, communication & worker engagement at all levels can help the chances of accidents occurring.

### Who Should Attend?

Managers, supervisors and workers from all construction/civil engineering trades.

It is recommended that all levels of personnel attend this course.

### Course Content:

The objective of the course is to enable delegates to, by the end of the course:

- List the basic legal duties of employers & employees
- Define hazards, risks & control measures
- List possible causes of accidents
- Appreciate the link between attitude & behaviour
- Appreciate the costs of poor safety performance
- Appreciate the benefits of good safety performance
- Putting ABC into practice using STAARR & TASK card

At the end of the course delegates are required to sit a paper based assessment.

On successful completion of the assessment, delegates will receive a CSkills Achieving Behavioural Change certificate.
