Course Objectives:

The course is designed for employees who are designated Fire Marshalls. It provides delegates with the knowledge to be able to fulfill the requirements of management of fire safety within the workplace.

Who Should Attend?

Existing Fire Marshalls as a refresher or those new to the role.

Duration: ½ day

Course Content:

At the end of the course, delegates will have covered the following:

- The role of the Fire Marshall
- Basic requirements of legislation
- The fire routine
- Evacuating personnel
- Assembly areas
- Head count and reporting missing personnel
- Basic fire prevention
- The theory of fire and its spread through buildings
- Active fire prevention defences
- Fire fighting equipment, type and use
- Basic principles of risk assessment

A practical session involving a tour of the working environment to spot fire hazards and raise awareness of evacuation routes and fire escapes completes the course.

On completion delegates will receive a Certificate of Attendance.
