



IOSH Directing Safely



Course Objectives:

This course aims to provide directors/owners of small and medium sized enterprises (fewer than 250 employees), with an understanding of the moral, legal and business case for proactive health and safety management and to give guidance on effective risk management.

Who Should Attend?

People who are strategically responsible for determining and implementing effective health and safety management within an organisation.

Course Content:

The course is split into 8 modules as follows:

- Aims and objectives
- Health and safety management – good business sense
- Health and safety – getting it wrong!
- Health and safety – getting it right!
- Planning for success
- People – your most valuable asset
- How well are you performing?
- Improving performance

At the end of the course there is a short assessment to ensure delegates have understood what they have been taught , using multi-format questions and a project.

On successful completion of the course, delegates will receive an IOSH Directing Safely Certificate.
