



IOSH Safety for Senior Executives

Course Objectives:

Effective management of health and safety is not only a legal requirement but also a well recognised means of improving workforce safety, morale and loyalty. In order to be able to defend civil claims, organisations must now be able to demonstrate that they are effectively managing their health and safety.

Who Should Attend?

Senior managers with strategic responsibility for determining and implementing effective health and safety management in an organisation.

Company Chief Executives, Senior Directors, Departmental Managers and other senior staff with health and safety responsibilities.

Duration: 1 day



Course Content:

The course covers the main areas of:

- Legislative requirements
- The costs of accidents and ill health at work
- The duty of care and negligence claims
- Responsibilities of Senior Managers
- The management of health and safety
- Risk assessment and control
- Powers of inspectors and enforcement
- Communication and consultation with the workforce

On completion of the course delegates will be able to:

- Understand the health and safety role and responsibilities of senior executives
- Recognise the importance of integrating health and safety objectives with other business objectives
- Understand the consequences of failing to manage health and safety
- Understand the requirements of current legislation with the potential consequences of non-compliance upon their organisation and themselves
